



**25. Slice of Reality**

A section of a dredger has been placed in the river here by artist Richard Wilson. After this you will turn back and walk down Drawdock Road

**23. Rubbish**

There is always rubbish on the slipway near Drawdock Road

**21. Industrial jetty**

A large metal gantry leads out to a dock here. There are benches nearby

**19. Quayside**

The path rejoins the river here and continues along the riverside; keep walking towards the Dome and listen

**16. Public jetty**

Walk to the end of this large jetty for a fantastic view of the riverscape

**14. Enderby's Wharf**

There is a fenced area here with machinery, exhibits and a carved jetty

**11. Lovell's Wharf**

The name of the wharf is written on the walls here. Look up for crane remains

**3. Greenwich foot tunnel**

You will be led down the tunnel and back via the lift (track 5)

**7. Greenwich Beach walkway**

Starting from the obelisk marked 'Bellot' you will walk and listen along the riverside path to the 'Trafalgar' pub

**9. Outside no.22 Crane St**

There is a large gate here that leads to the foreshore

**27. Millennium Motel**

The last track should be played at the motel on Tunnel Avenue, a blue and yellow building with caravans outside

**END: North Greenwich tube**




**MEMORYSCAPE: Docks**

You can walk, wheel or boat your way along the route.

Play track 1 first for an introduction to the walk, and follow the instructions.

All directions will be given on the soundtrack - this map will help you get your bearings.

At each soundpoint  you will play the track number listed here on your player.

Track numbers not shown on this map are walking directions between the soundpoints and can be replayed on the walk if you wish.

**1. START: Cutty Sark**

Start outside the Cutty Sark ship in Greenwich. Play the first track and keep listening. The instructions will lead you down to the Greenwich Foot Tunnel. Keep listening for instructions
